5 Week Study Abroad Experience

WHO CAN APPLY Indiana High School Students in Japanese Level II and above (sophomores, juniors, and seniors).

WHAT: A unique opportunity for students to immerse themselves in the Japanese language and culture under the guidance of highly qualified instructors. Courses include Grammar, Communication, Phonetics, Literature, and Culture. Students engage in afternoon activities, such as art, music, sports, dance, and theater. Students live with dedicated host families and visit important cultural and historical sites such as Kyoto, Koyasan, and Tokyo.

WHEN: 5 weeks during June and July. Students apply in the fall.
